## SLUM INHABITANTS GET COVID JOBS

Bhubaneswar: Vulnerable community people from slum pockets in the 18-44 and 45 and above age groups were administered more than 150 Covaxin jabs at Nilachal Hospital, Bhubaneswar, recently.
